

DSMC Operations Status

- Ground Network
 - On May 9, 2002 the GN 9 Meter transition for STS/Contingency support was completed.
 - Following the transition, STS-111 was nominally supported by DSMC schedulers.

DSMC Operations Status

- Space Network
 - On June 25, 2002 the SN transition of the NCCDS from the NCC to the DSMC was completed.
 - Operations has been nominal since the SN transition.
 - DSMC schedulers have provided realtime support for two STS missions at the NCC and one through the “remote workstations” at the DSMC.
 - STS-112 will be the first STS mission supported by the DSMC system.

DSMC SN LAUNCH VECTOR MANAGEMENT

- STS-112 will be supported by the DSMC Launch Vector Management team.
- Jim Cappellari will be present at WSC for the STS-112 proficiency sims, vector verification test and the launch.
- Training and certification for all members of the vector management was complete by Dr. Cappellari last spring. Proficiency sims have been run prior to ELV/Shuttle missions since certification.

DSMC PCD Activities

- NCC Technical Manager Transition
 - Effective 0000Z on 09/16/02, the transition of all NCC TM functions to the White Sands Complex has been completed
 - The WSC Operations Supervisor is now the point of contact for GN and SN activities that were coordinated by the TM.
- Human Space Flight and Special Mission Planning
 - Planner position will be retained through FY03
 - Functions under review, continued streamlining with DSMC expected.
